Dave Chun teaches Business Law at Austin Community College. He brings more than 20 years of experience in contracts, compliance, and legal operations to the classroom, helping students connect legal principles to the decisions organizations make every day.

His career has centered on the places where law meets operations: negotiating large-scale federal and state government contracts, building commercial contracting and compliance functions inside growing companies, handling B2B SaaS agreements and the disputes that follow them, and working on Fair Credit Reporting Act compliance in the background screening industry. Across those roles, the recurring question was the same one this course asks: where does legal risk actually enter a business decision, and what does a company do about it before it becomes a dispute?

He holds a B.A. from Washington University in St. Louis and a J.D. from Saint Louis University. In his courses, students apply principles of contract formation, agency, torts, and business organizations to realistic transactions and disputes. His goal is for business students to leave able to identify legal and ethical issues early, communicate sound recommendations, and make better business decisions.
